**Tuesday, September 12, 2017**

**DEPART SAN FRANCISCO or LOS ANGELES**

**From SFO:** Our journey begins as we depart San Francisco on flight KL606 to Amsterdam at 1:55pm.

**From LAX:** We depart Los Angeles on flight KL602 to Amsterdam at 1:45pm.

**Wednesday, September 13, 2017**

**ARRIVE LISBON/SANTAREM/FATIMA**

From SFO: Arrive Amsterdam at 9:15am and transfer to KL1693 to Lisbon at 12:45pm.

From LAX: Arrive Amsterdam at 9:05am and transfer KL1693 to Lisbon at 12:45pm.

Arrive Lisbon at 2:45pm where we will be greeted by our tour guide and bus driver. We drive to visit Santarem, one of the oldest cities in the world and home to one of the oldest Eucharistic Miracles in the world. On to Fatima for overnight. We will join in the festivities to celebrate the year of the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima.

**Thursday, September 14, 2017**

**FATIMA**

We will spend the full day Fatima and join pilgrims from around the world as we celebrate the year of the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima. Visit the Chapel of the Apparitions, the Basilica and the tombs of Francisco, Jacinta and Sr. Lucia, and monument to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We share in the festivities at this special event. After dinner we join in the nightly rosary and candlelight procession.



**Friday, September 15, 2017**

**FATIMA/AVILA**

Today we drive to Avila. Upon arrival, we visit

the Monastery of the Incarnation, St. Teresa's cell and see the relics of St. Teresa and St. John of the Cross. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

**Saturday, September 16, 2017**

**AVILA/SEGOVIA/LOURDES**

This morning in Avila, we visit the city enclosed by high walls, which dates from the middle ages. We walk the narrow streets of the city as we trace the life of St. Teresa of Avila. Then to Lourdes. En-route, we stop in Segovia for a visit to the Convent of Saint John of the Cross with the Discalced Carmelite friars and the Convent of Saint Joseph with the cloistered Discalced Carmelite nuns. Overnight in Lourdes.

**Sunday, September 17, 2017**

**LOURDES**

Visit the historical and spiritual sites associated with the visionary child Bernadette. We begin at the Grotto of the Apparitions, and then continue on a guided walking tour visiting the Basilica of St. Pius X, Boly Mill, Soubirous family home, the Basilica of the Rosary, the miraculous spring and the healing baths. After dinner, we will join in the nightly rosary and candlelight procession.

**Monday, September 18, 2017**

**LOURDES/NEVERS**

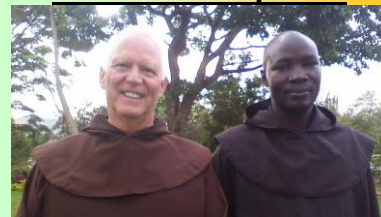
Today we depart to Nevers. We arrive late afternoon and we visit the sights associated with St. Bernadette. On the St. Gildard convent grounds lies the chapel containing the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. We see the statue of Our Lady of Waters, Bernadette's favorite statue and replica of Lourdes Grotto.

**Tuesday, September 19, 2017**

**NEVERS/LISIEUX/PARIS**

This morning we drive to Lisieux. We visit the sacred places of St. Therese and her recently canonized parents, St. Louis Martin and St. Marie Zélie Guérin Martin. We have

a guided visit of the Basilica of Saint Therese, one of the largest churches built in the XX century. Then we visit the Carmel where Saint Therese lived and we see her reliquary brought here in 1923. On to les Buissonnets and the Carmelite convent. In the afternoon we continue to Paris for dinner and overnight.

**Wednesday, September 20, 2017**

**PARIS/DIJON**

This morning we visit Cathedral of Notre Dame which is widely considered to be one of the finest examples of French Gothic architecture and among the largest and most well-known church buildings in the world. We visit the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, St. Vincent de Paul and the Sacred Heart Basilica. Then we travel to Dijon.

**Thursday, September 21, 2017**

**DIJON/PARAY LE MONIAL/  
AIX EN PROVENCE**

We visit Dijon to see the birthplace of Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity, the latest Carmelite Saint. We see some of the important reliquary associated with her. On to Paray le Monial where we visit the Chapel of the Visitation where Jesus exposed His Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. God chose her to be the instrument to lead the world back to Christ. We drive to Aix en Provence for overnight.

**Friday, September 22, 2017**

**AIX EN PROVENCE/SIENA**

Today we drive to Siena. We reach Siena late afternoon. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**Saturday, September 23, 2017**

**SIENA/ASSISI**

We will delight in exploring Siena, birthplace of one of the most popular saints, St. Catherine, patron saint of Italy and of Europe. We tour the city's major treasures, including the fabulous marble Gothic Duomo Cathedral, the Piazza

del Campo—town square—and the Torre del Mangia, an architectural treasure famous for hosting the Palio horse races twice a year. Drive to Assisi. In Assisi our sightseeing tour includes visits to the Church of St. Clare, which houses her incorrupt body. One of the chapels contains the crucifix that bowed its head and ordered St. Francis to “repair God’s Church”. Afterwards, we will tour the Basilica of St. Francis built in 1228 to house the relics of the saint. Mass will be celebrated here at the Basilica of St. Francis. After break for lunch, visit the Church of Santa Maria degli Angeli, containing the famous Porziuncola. *The favorite refuge of St. Francis.*

**Sunday, September 24, 2017**  
**ASSISI/SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO**

This morning we visit San Damiano, a church with a monastery near Assisi, Italy. Built in the 12th century, it was the first monastery of the Order of Saint Clare, where Saint Clare built her community. On to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight.

**Monday, September 25, 2017**  
**SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO/ROME**

This morning in San Giovanni Rotondo we will visit the places where the Franciscan Padre Pio da Pietralcina lived, labored, and in 1968 died here. We celebrate Mass in the convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie where Padre Pio lived. Then we drive to Rome for dinner and overnight.

**Tuesday, September 26, 2017**  
**ROME/BASILICAS/VATICAN MUSEUMS**

Today we visit the major Basilicas of Rome: The Basilica of St. Mary Major, the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the Holy Stairs and the Basilica of St. Paul’s Outside the Walls. In the afternoon, visit the Vatican Museums which house what can be described as the most important collections of art in the world. We will enjoy a panoramic tour of Imperial Rome with stops at the Spanish Steps and the Trevi Fountain.

**Wednesday, September 27, 2017**  
**DEPART ROME/SAN FRANCISCO OR**  
**LOS ANGELES**

**To SFO:** We transfer to Rome airport for flight KL1596 to Amsterdam at 6:20am. Arrive Amsterdam at 8:50am and transfer to flight KL607 to San Francisco at 12:50pm. Arrive San Francisco at 2:45pm.

**To LAX:** We transfer to flight KL1596 to Amsterdam at 6:20am. Arrive Amsterdam at 8:50am and transfer to flight KL603 to Los Angeles at 12:45pm. Arrive Los Angeles at 2:50pm.
