Sunday, October 9, 2016 DEPART SAN FRANCISCO

Our journey begins as we depart San Francisco at 9:55am on flight DL61. Arrive Atlanta at 5:40pm and transfer to flight DL64 to Rome at 6:44pm.

Monday, October 10, 2016 ARRIVE ROME/ASSISI

Upon arrival to Rome at 10:15am, meet our tour escort inside the baggage claim area. Board the bus and drive to Assisi (approximately 3 hrs.). Based on the flight and arrival time in Assisi, we will celebrate Mass in the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels in Porziuncola.

Tuesday, October 11, 2016 ASSISI/CASCIA/NORCIA/ASSISI

After breakfast, we visit the Church of St. Clare, which houses her incorrupt body. Continue to the Basilica of St. Francis, built in 1228 to house the Relics of the saint. The "upper" basilica houses beautiful frescoes of Giotto which describe the life of St. Francis and his community. Continue to Cascia (approximately 1.5 hrs). Visit the monastery where St. Rita spent her life as a nun and where she died. Visit the Basilica which houses her incorrupt body. Celebrate Mass. Time permitting, we will visit the village of Norcia, birthplace of St. Benedict and his twin sister St Scholastica. Return to Assisi for dinner and overnight.



Wednesday, October 12, 2016 ASSISI/SIENA/FLORENCE

After breakfast, we drive to Sienna

(approximately 2.5 hrs). We will delight in exploring the birthplace of one of the most popular saints, St. Catherine, patron saint of Italy and of Europe. The ancient city is also famous for its cuisine and the rich red color of its medieval cityscape. The historic center has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We tour the city's major treasures, including the fabulous marble Gothic Duomo Cathedral, the Piazza del Campo—town square—and the Torre del Mangia, an architectural treasure famous for hosting the Palio horse races twice a year. Celebrate Mass in San Domenico, the church which houses relics of Saint Catherine. Free time for shopping and then continue to Florence for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, October 13, 2016 FLORENCE/ROME

This morning we will start a walking tour through the streets of Florence stopping to visit the Duomo (Cathedral of St. Mary of the Flowers), see also Giotto's Bells Tower and the Baptistery Doors (Gates of Paradise). Continue to (the Signoria Square "open-air museum"). We will visit places associated with Carmelite Saint including St. Margaret Redi. Break for lunch. Then we visit the Franciscan church of Santa Croce, which houses the tombs of many Italian artists, among which Galileo and Michelangelo. Here we will Celebrate Mass. Time at leisure to shop for gold on the Ponte Vecchio Bridge or to visit a leather factory. Continue to Rome for dinner and overnight.

Friday, October 14, 2016 ROME/MONTECASSINO/ROME

After breakfast, we will drive towards the south to reach the Benedictine Abbey of Montecassino. Upon arrival, we visit the

Abbey founded by Saint Benedict in 529. The abbey has been destroyed four times, most recently in World War II. Then we celebrate Holy Mass. After break for lunch, we will return to Rome. Hotel dinner and overnight.

Saturday, October 15, 2016 ROME/BASILICAS/IMPERIAL ROME

This morning, after a good breakfast, we will start our guided tour of Christian Rome: the Major Basilicas of Rome. Basilica of St. Mary Major which is the largest in Rome dedicated to the Blessed Mother, Basilica of St. John Lateran which is the oldest of the major basilicas and ranks first as the actual "parish church" of the Pope (Bishop of Rome). There we will learn about the Scala Sancta (Holy Stairs). After break for lunch, we will celebrate Holy Mass in honor of Our Holy Mother Teresa of Avila in the Convento Teresianum. Continue with a tour of Imperial Rome including the Palatino Hill, the Circo Maximo, Trajan's market, Trajan's Forum and Column, Arch of Constantine, House of Knights of Rhodes and the Coliseum (outside). Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.



Sunday, October 16, 2016 CANONIZATION/HOLY DOOR

Very early morning transfer to St. Peter's square to attend the ceremony of canonization of Blessed Elizabeth of the

Trinity, a Carmelite nun of the 20th century who said: "I think that in heaven my mission will be to draw souls, by helping them go out of themselves to cling to God by a wholly simple and loving movement." In the afternoon we will enter the Basilica passing by the HOLY DOOR and celebrate the Jubilee of Divine Mercy. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Monday, October 17, 2016 **VATICAN MUSEUMS/ FOUNTAINS AND SQUARES**

After breakfast, transfer to the Vatican, where we meet our guide and begin another full day of sightseeing in Rome. We visit the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel, the celebrated Chapel of the Popes and the venue of the Conclaves for Papal elections. It is one of the most splendid masterpieces in the history of world art and is well known around the world for its magnificent ceiling, beautifully decorated by Michelangelo. We will also visit the interiors of San Peter's Basilica, completely covered by mosaics. Free time for lunch. In the afternoon we continue our walking tour with the guide, throughout the Baroque area of Rome: see Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, and Navona Square. We will also have the chance to visit the Church of San Luigi de' Francesi to be "enchanted" by the beauty of the Caravaggio's masterpiece about the life of St. Matthew. Here we will celebrate Holy Mass. We have a restaurant farewell dinner. Return to the hotel and overnight.

Tuesday, October 18, 2016 **DEPART ROME/SAN FRANCISCO**

We depart Rome on flight DL63 to Atlanta at 9:15am. Arrive Atlanta at 2:41pm and transfer to flight DL2611 to San Francisco at 4:40pm. Arrive San Francisco at 7:03pm.
