The OCDS Provincial Council and our new Provincial Delegate of the California – Arizona Province of St. Joseph are inviting a leader from each community or group within our OCDS Province to be selected and sent to the upcoming 2024 Leadership Conference. It is highly suggested that the person who is to be sent be the president or leader, or formation director, of the community or group. If that is not possible, then at minimum, the person should be a member of the local council, as the conference will be addressing information to be implemented soon after the person returns. This is the first such conference since 2018 and the council has been requested to assist with pertinent and immediate needs. We also invite leaders to express their concerns and needs for the future as well.

The conference will once again be held at El Carmelo Retreat House in Redlands, California. Leaders will arrive on Tuesday, May 14th and depart Friday May 17th. Space is limited and rooms will be available on a first come first served basis. Some, to save money, can also share rooms on a voluntary basis. Local hotel arrangements can also be made if needed.

The cost of the conference will include lodging for 3 nights and 8 meals, starting with dinner on Tuesday and ending with breakfast on Friday. Two socials will also be included. The cost of the conference will be announced in the next few weeks and will not include travel expenses. Please remember this conference will benefit all members of a community or group. It is highly recommended that the costs be shared amongst all members in sending the chosen representative. This can be accomplished through the community's treasury, additional dues, or by taking a separate collection.

To all OCDS Presidents, Group Leaders, Formation Directors and Formators,

We are aware that there are some minor corrections that need to be made to the Formation Handbooks and those will be addressed in a future revised edition. Of course, the other alternative is to purchase "The Way of Perfection: Study Edition."
